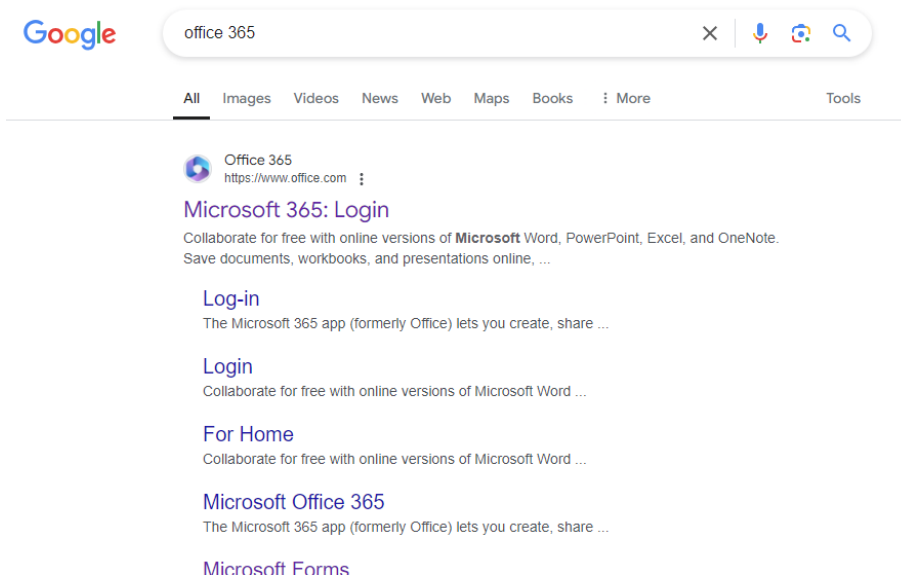


School Emails

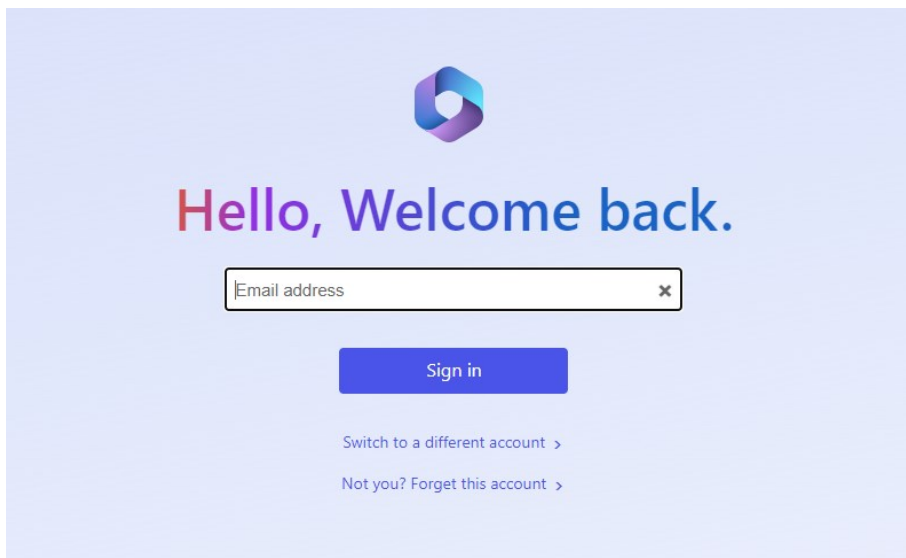

Students can access their emails at home or at school. Instructions below:

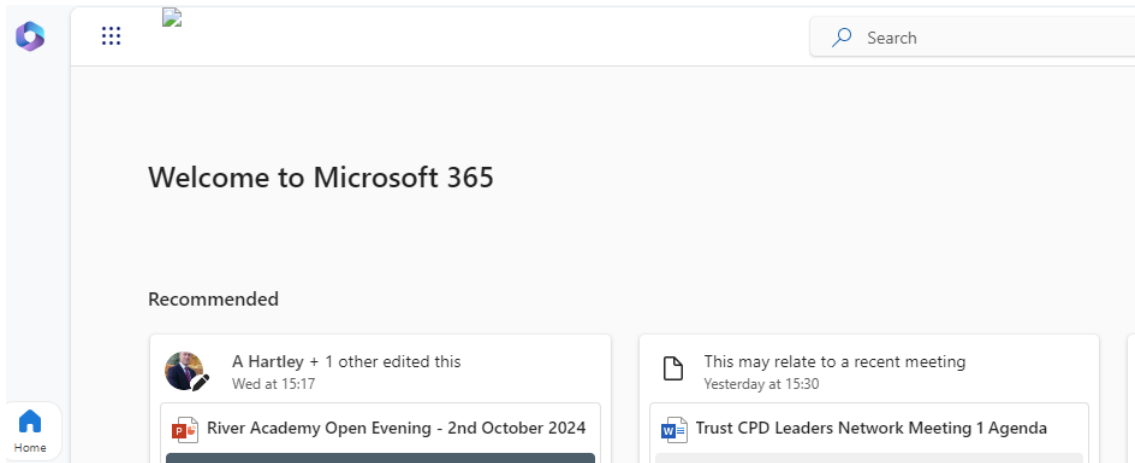
1. Log in to Office 365 (search for Office 365 and click into the first link as seen below)



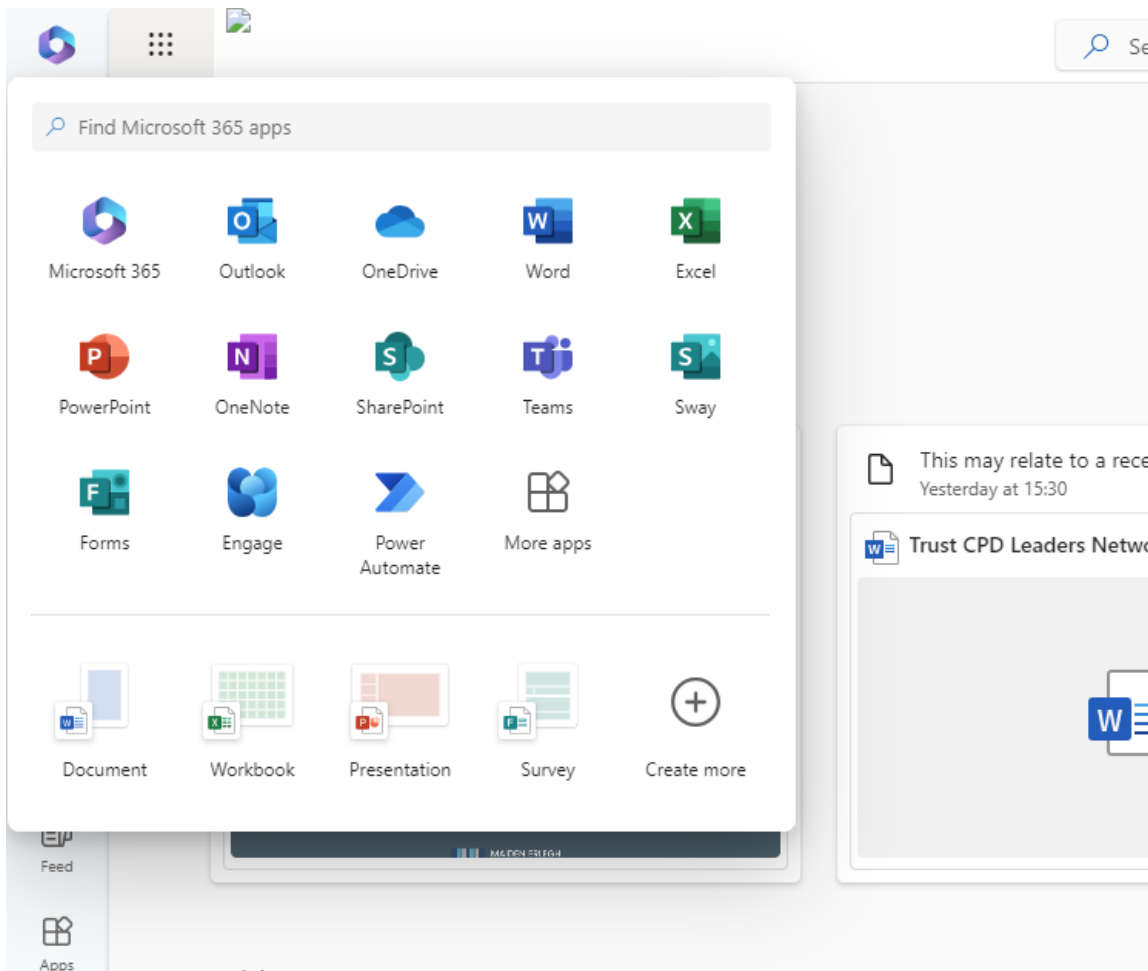
2. Use your school email address and password to log in:



3. Click into the 9 dots on the top left corner:



4. Click 'Outlook'



5. And your emails will appear!

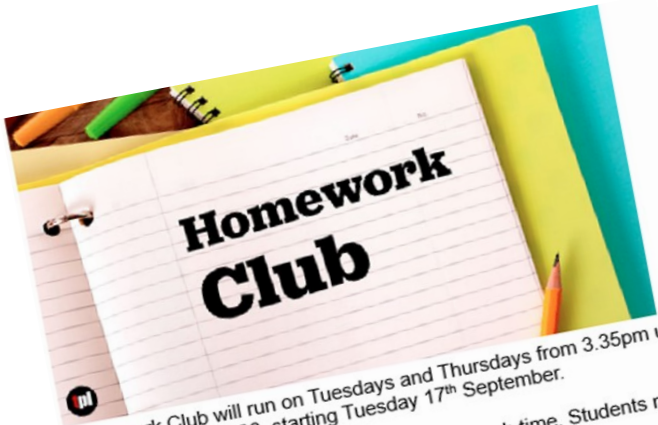
